Sunday Clubs: Primary-age children hear a Bible story and explore ideas about it, have a craft activity and play games together.

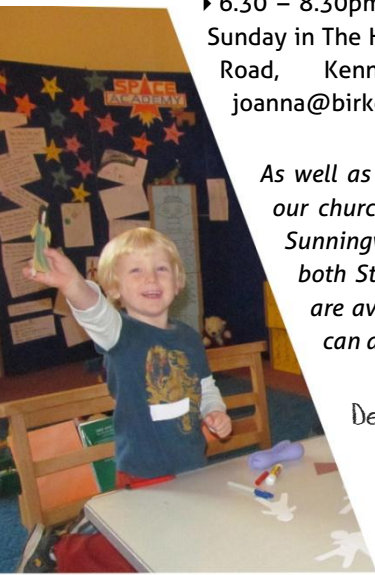
